Television

RTÉ Cork produced approximately 70 hours of television programmes in 2000, including **Wordwitch**, a new educational children's programme, taught children phonetics and word building and **Herbal Infusion**, a six-part series, focused on the use of herbs in the broadest possible context.

The tragic death of **No Disco** presenter Uaneen Fitzsimons in November was devastating to her colleagues and fans. During the year, the music show continued to champion artists who do not conform to the corporate pop world. The team ended 2000 compiling a one-hour tribute programme to Uaneen.

The consumer programme **Streetwise** covered a record number of complaints and generated more consumer enquiries than ever. For the first time, the series utilised the expertise of the European Consumer Centre in Dublin.

Behind The Rose, an hour-long documentary, followed three Rose of Tralee entrants through their hometown competitions to the final.

The documentary **164 Lives, 50 Years: The Kerlogue Rescue**, told the story of Wexford man Tom O'Neill and his friendship with a group of Germans that began during World War II when Tom and the crew of the MV Kerlogue saved 164 German naval cadets from drowning in the Bay of Biscay.

The marine programme **Out of the Blue** (in its fourth series), presented by Derek Davis, and a second series of **Citizens** were produced during the year for transmission in early 2001.

Michael Ryan and his **Nationwide** team continued to bring viewers a wide variety of regional news stories and information from all over Ireland. Regional opt-outs (Dublin, Cork and Galway) started in November.

Following the closure of RTÉ Radio Cork, Aonghus McAnally moved to Cork in January 2000 as commissioning producer to identify areas where the Cork studios could play a more significant role in the national schedule. The result was a series of new programmes produced by RTÉ Cork including:

Southern Exposure, a six-part series written and presented by Conal Creedon. This looked at six popular Munster holiday destinations, as they are now and how they were in the past; **Mothers of Invention**, a series produced by Donna O'Sullivan in which women talked about how creativity influenced their lives was; **A Question of Food**, presented by Derek Davis, with expert chefs offering culinary advice on a different style of cuisine each week; **It's a Funny Business**, produced and presented by Alf McCarthy, an eight-part series featuring interviews with Irish comedians; **The Usual Suspects** looked at the political and cultural life of Ireland using the framework of fictional sixties television cop shows.

RTÉ Radio One World, RTÉ's service for the asylum-seeking, refugee and immigrant communities living in Ireland, continued nightly on 1278metres on the medium waveband, produced by Marcus Connaughton.

Ongoing radio programmes included **Late Date** from the Cork studios three nights a week, presented by Lillian Smith; **The Irish Collection**, broadcast daily between 2am and 6am with highlights of the previous day's Radio 1 programming, presented by Steve Bolger and Daragh Murphy; **Seascapes**, the weekly maritime news and information programme presented by Tom MacSweeney. Since Summer 2000 John Creedon presents his lunchtime Radio 1 show from the Cork studios.

News

2000 was another busy news year in the Southern Region, with industrial disputes, drug hauls and some major controversies making national headlines. Among the sporting highlights were the return home of the victorious Kerry footballers and the hometown welcome for Olympic silver medallist Sonia O'Sullivan. The state-of-the art technology now available for coverage of such events is a testament to RTÉ's commitment to regional broadcasting; inaccessibility and distance are no longer influencing factors in the depth of coverage afforded to News in some of the most isolated parts of Ireland.

Year 2000 was extremely active for RTÉ's Performing Groups. Highlights of the NSO calendar included the launch of the 2000/2001 Season, featuring the composer Sergei Rachmaninov, the New Year's Day Viennese concert, now established as an annual event in the Dublin calendar, the opening concert of the Bord Gais International Choral Festival in Cork, the Wexford Festival Opera and the NSO's bi-annual tour to Galway, Limerick, Cork and Waterford, jointly sponsored by RTÉ and The Irish Times. In addition, the NSO accompanied the Finalists at the RTÉ Millennium Musician of the Future Festival in February and the Axa Dublin International Piano Competition in May.

The RTÉ Concert Orchestra also had an active year appearing around Ireland and internationally. In February the Orchestra embarked on its very successful **Music for Middlebrows** Tour to Clonmel, Limerick, Clifden, Sligo, Athlone and Tullamore. This was followed by the **Music from the Movies** Tour to Donegal, Sligo and Dublin, a joint choral event between the Setanta Choir and the Armagh City Choir in Armagh and Dundalk and a **Hooked on Classics** Tour in Dublin, Galway, Cork and Limerick. Highlights of the year included the RTÉCO's performance for President McAleese and other dignitaries at Expo 2000, its two seasons with Opera Ireland in which it reached new levels of critical acclaim with **Katya Kabanova** and **Lady Macbeth of Mtsensk** and a new television series on RTÉ One with Gay Byrne. The year finished with a major New Year's Eve concert marking the anniversary celebrations of 75 years of radio in Ireland.

The RTÉ Vanbrugh String Quartet continued to attract audiences with its Spring and Autumn seasons which toured to Dublin, Cork, Carlow, Castlebar, Cahirciveen, Clifden, Gorey, Limerick, Lismore, Listowel, New Ross, Mullingar, Wexford, Wicklow. The Quartet took up its residency once again at the renowned West Cork Chamber Music Festival and, in December, was heard in over 20 countries worldwide when its concert in Limerick was transmitted by Lyric FM in association with the European Broadcasting Union.

RTÉ's two choral groups, The RTÉ Philharmonic Choir and Cór na nÓg RTÉ continued their performances throughout the year. Highlights of the Philharmonic Choir's Season were its performance of Beethoven's **Missa Solemnis** as part of the Bord Gáis International Choral Festival and **L'Enfance du Christ** by Berlioz in December. Cór na nÓg RTÉ, meanwhile, continued its commitment to the development of young choristers and engaged in a cross-cultural exchange of music and language with the Welsh choir, Ysgol Gerdd Ceredigion in October (involving performances in Dublin and Cardiff). Its year ended with two sell-out Christmas Concerts in Trinity College, Dublin.

2000 has been a busy year for all of the performing groups and 2001 promises to be equally active. Some special concerts are planned for later in the year as RTÉ continues its longstanding commitment to playing a major role in the development of music in Ireland and to providing all kinds of music to the widest possible audiences countrywide.

Níor tosaíodh ar Eagrúchán agus Forbairt mar fheidhm ann féin in RTÉ go dtí 1997 leis an bhfreagracht shonrach go ndíreofaí ar fhorbairt straitéiseach agus tráchtála na heagraíochta craolacháin náisiúnta tráth a raibh bunchlaochlú ag teacht ar an timpeallacht chraolacháin agus ar theicneolaíochtaí cumarsáide. Bliain rishuaithe seach a bhí i 2000 don ghrúpa seo ina bhfuil Pearsanra, Teicneolaíocht, Pleanáil Ghnó, Gnóthaí Dlí agus Gnóthaí Poiblí. Caitheadh cuid mhór de dhua na bainistíochta agus na foirne á chinntiú go leanfadh RTÉ ag forbairt mar mhórchraoltóir na n-ilmheán thar speictream uile na seirbhísí analógacha agus digiteacha.

Ghéaraigh an ráta claochlaithe in RTÉ go mór i mbliana faoi réir plean trí bliana d'innmharthanacht airgeadais a comhaontaíodh, agus nuair a tugadh an Comhaontú Claochlaithe chun críche mí Aibreáin. Ba thoradh ar na mionna fada de ghrinnsaothar an plean agus an deilbh-chomhaontú a tháinig as. Nuair a bhí an méid sin réitithe, thosaigh RTÉ ar phróiseas athphlé ar nósanna oibre agus ar éifeacht oibríochta, bord ar bhord le hathbheithniúcháin ar leith ar réimsí gníomhaíochta áirithe. Ba thoradh amháin air seo gur seoladh raon de roghanna luathscóir agus scartha a beartaíodh chun an líon foirne a bhíonn ag plé leis na seirbhísí atá againn faoi láthair a laghdú de bhreis agus trí chéad faoi dheireadh 2002.

ORGANISATION AND DEVELOPMENT

Liam Miller *Managing Director – Organisation and Development*

The Organisation and Development function was only introduced in 1997 in RTÉ with a specific responsibility to focus on the strategic and commercial development of the national broadcasting organisation at a time of fundamental change in the broadcasting environment and communications technologies. 2000 has proved to be a very significant year for this grouping, which includes Personnel, Technology, Business Planning, Legal Affairs and Public Affairs. Much of the effort of the management team and staff has been devoted to ensuring that RTÉ continues to develop as the leading multi media broadcaster across the full spectrum of analogue and digital services.

The pace of change in RTÉ has increased dramatically within the framework of an agreed three-year financial viability plan and with the completion of the Transformation Agreement in April 2001. Both the plan and the subsequent framework agreement were the culmination of many months of dedicated work. With these initiatives in place, RTÉ commenced a process of detailed renegotiation of work practice and operational effectiveness issues side by side with specific reviews of particular areas of activity. One outcome of this was the launch of severance and early retirement options designed to reduce the numbers of staff involved with existing services by over three hundred by the end of 2002.

In addition to a clear focus on the efficiency and value for money in current services, Organisation and Development has also been centrally involved in the planning of a range of new developments including the transition to digital broadcasting channels, the establishment of a digital media division and supporting the Executive Board and Authority in making the case to the public and to the legislators for increased public funding for public service broadcasting. This group is also taking a lead role in the launch of digital terrestrial television in Ireland by managing the sale of RTÉ's Transmission Network assets and in the creation of a joint venture to run the national transmission infrastructure.

The Transformation Agreement was signed by RTÉ, the Trade Union Group and RTÉ Managers Association. This first step in addressing urgent organisational change sets out in partnership an agreed ambitious change agenda for the next three years.

RTÉ's plan to reduce the number of staff employed by 330 nett is currently being implemented. To date staff reductions are broadly in line with divisional and corporate plans.

Significant advances were made in local partnership discussions on restructuring in many work areas, including Television Programmes and negotiations towards a digital Newsroom.

The year also saw the beginning of development in preparation for the new digital channels which will be carried on the Netco transmission system.

The Staff Development Centre was set up and its services availed of by significant staff numbers. The Centre has been established to allow rapid organisational transformation by facilitating change in human resource deployment, capabilities and attitudes so as to match staffing to business needs.

Training and staff development provision responded directly to many rapidly developing areas of activity over the wide gamut of RTÉ's needs.

The RTÉ Commercial Division incorporates Television and Radio Advertising, Commercial Enterprises Ltd.(CEL), the Facilities Business Unit, and the TV Licence Fee Unit. In total, the Commercial Division employs 663 people and is responsible for all revenue-generating activities within RTÉ. Total revenue generated in 2000 was £200m.

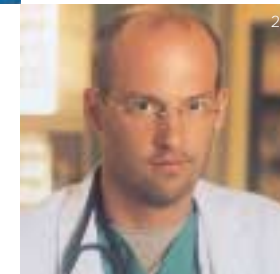
Television and Radio Advertising

The Television and Radio Advertising team, headed by Geraldine O'Leary, Director of Sales and Marketing, encompasses three Business Units, a Sponsorship section, and the London Sales Office. As part of the strategic plan for the year 2000, a Belfast Office was established in December, in line with RTÉ's increased availability in Northern Ireland.

RTÉ Sales employs 51 people and generated £111.1m revenue in the year 2000. Radio revenue for 2000 was £22.6m, showing a 14% increase year on year, and Television generated revenue of £86m with 4% growth year on year. Sponsorship of programmes saw some major new sports and entertainment sponsorships including Fair City (Conduit 11850), Ally McBeal (Cadbury's Flake), Euro 2000 (Carlsberg) and ER (Irish Life), delivering £2.5m in 2000, achieving 32% growth year on year. The sponsorship guidelines have been under review in the past year and revised guidelines will soon be available for both internal and external use.

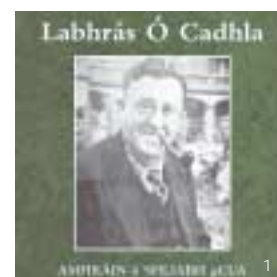

RTÉ Online is the leading provider of online multimedia in Ireland, offering popular News and Sports services and an Arts Culture and Entertainment site (ACE). It supports the live webcasting of RTÉ's four radio stations and provides live webcasting of RTÉ One, Network 2 and TG4 television programmes in Real Video format. There is also an extensive archive in Real Audio format.

Major new web sites launched in 2000 include:

ACE – Arts, Culture & Entertainment, launched at the end of 2000, provides a guide to cultural events throughout the country. The site features news, reviews and interviews covering arts and entertainment, audio and video features from RTÉ Radio and Television and new multimedia content. The site also provides interactive elements such as chat forums, bulletin boards, online interviews and newsletters.

Ceolnet – was developed throughout the latter part of 2000 and launched on January 1st, 2001, coinciding with the commencement of the 75th anniversary celebrations of Irish Radio. This site provides live Internet broadcasting of Irish traditional music from the RTÉ Traditional Music Archive. The launch of this site is part of a project to develop new content in audio and multi-media formats on the Internet. Other such projects in the pipeline include an Irish language learning site with audio and a children's radio service.

RTÉ Sport Online and RTÉ News Online continue to provide the latest News and Sport information, with breaking news stories and the latest sports results.

Traffic through the rte.ie URL was nearly six million page impressions per month, with 250,000 unique users monthly. Live audio streams are accessed over 100,000 times per month and the news site sends in excess of 20,000 e-mail newsletters to subscribers every day. In October 2000, RTÉ Internet Services won a major international award – Cyber Hero of the Year for promoting the dot.ie domain.

Is é an bonn custaiméara atá i gceist, Clár Theilifíse RTÉ, Nuacht, Raidió agus cuideachtaí seachtracha léiriúcháin. Bhí tionchar mór ar Áiseanna Léiriúcháin ag díralú thionscal na teilifíse, go náisiúnta is go himheánach, mar aon leis an dualgas atá ar RTÉ faoin dlí cuid mhór den léiriúcháin a fháil ón taobh amuigh. Ag freagairt do na dúshláin sin, tá rannóg na nÁiseanna Léiriúcháin Teilifíse bunaithe mar ghnóthas lántrádála, gan deontas seirbhíse poiblí, a chuirfidh breisluach le RTÉ.

Facilities Business Unit

Tony O'Connor is Director of Television Production Facilities, the largest Division in the organisation. Over 600 staff were working in this division in 1999 and a reduction of 20% is planned by December 2002. By the end of 2000, the staffing level had been reduced to 530 working across eight departments. The Division underwent major restructuring in 2000 and the Facilities Business Unit now operates its own Finance and Sales functions as part of RTÉ's commercial operation.

The Division provides all the technical and human resources required for television production (apart from Production staff) – Television studios, Outside Broadcast, Design, satellite, technical, film crews, post production and seven regional studio operations. The customer base comprises RTÉ Television Programmes, News, Radio and external production companies. The deregulation of the television industry, nationally and internally, combined with RTÉ's legal obligation to outsource a considerable proportion of production, has had a major impact on Production Facilities. To meet these challenges, Television Production Facilities division is established as a fully traded business, free from public service subsidy, which will add value to RTÉ.

The Facilities Business Unit has started trading internally and externally using industry market rates. Providing facilities to independent programme makers represents an expanding business opportunity. Other sources of new business include the new Digital Channels, TG4 and other broadcasters at home and abroad. Internal work includes everything from the **Late Late Show** to All Ireland Football & Hurling matches and examples of external work vary from **Who Wants to be a Millionaire** (Tyrone Productions), **Custer's Last Stand Up** (BBC London) to Horse Racing.

Licence Fee Unit

Although it is a legal requirement, not everyone who owns a television set holds a current television licence. Running at 15.3%, Ireland has one of the highest rates of evasion of television licence payment in Europe. In order to maximise the revenue accruing to RTÉ from the Television Licence Fee, RTÉ decided to set up a Licence Fee Unit to work with the collection agency to minimise collection costs and minimise evasion. Gerri McCaffrey is the Business Development Executive in the Licence Fee Unit which was set up towards the end of 2000.

RANNÓG PLEANÁLA GNÓ

BUSINESS PLANNING DIVISION

The transformation of the business culture within RTÉ involves the achievement of greater management accountability and the management of change.

The Business Planning Division is leading and supporting this new business focus that enables action based goal setting and tighter reporting on the performance of management. Business Planning co-ordinates the production of the three-year Corporate Strategy, the underlying financial and manpower plans, annual divisional business plans and key performance indicators.

Athraíodh go sásúil go bliain an 2000 agus dhirigh Rannóg na Teicneolaíochta ansan ar uasghrádú leanúnach na gcóras ríomhaireachta agus feidhmiúcháin. I measc na nithe ar chaith an Rannóg diríú orthu i rith na bliana bhí an t-athrú go dtí an Euro in Eanáir 2002, an claochlú leanúnach go léiriúchán digiteach raidió agus teilifíse, iarrachtaí i dtreo feabhsuithe caighdeáin agus méadú ar tháirgiocht, mar aon leis an riachtanas go gcoimeádfai bonneagar teicniúil RTÉ ag feidhmiú go barréifeachtach.

Ar thairseach na timpeallachta ilchainéil digítí, ba ríluachmhar an taithí, teicniúil agus feidhmiúil, a fuarthas ón gclár píolótach do scar-roghanna réigiúnacha a seoladh san fhómhar.

Sealús agus Bonneagar: Feistíodh Foirgneamh nua na gClár Teilifíse agus lonnainíodh breis is 400 ball foirne ann i dtréimhse chúig mhí. Tosaíodh ar an gclár chun Ríomhairí Pearsanta nua le hardsonraíocht a thabhairt ar bráid san fhoirgneamh sin agus leanfar de ar ráta 800 sa bhliain nó mar sin.

Timpeallacht: Bhain mórán dúshlán leis an mbliain seo. Táthar ag treisiú ar na rialacháin agus bíonn an-obair le déanamh dá réir maidir le diúscairt bruscair agus sláinteachas. Beidh orainn roinnt mhaith acmhainní a dhíriú orthu seo sa bhliain romhainn.

NETCO: Leanadh den phleanáil chun tosú ar Theilifís Thalmhaí Dhigiteach (TTD) i rith na bliana. Deineadh dul chun cinn sa tionscnamh le gnó ghréasán tarchuradóireachta RTÉ a dhíol agus tá an réimse oibríochta lánnullmhaithe anois lena dhíol, de réir mar a mheasaimid, i lár 2001. Coimeádfaidh RTÉ scair 28% sa chuideachta nua. Is í an chuideachta nua a bheidh mar phríomhsholáthróir na seirbhísí raidió agus teilifíse, analógach agus digiteach, do RTÉ agus do chraoltóirí ceadúnaithe tráchtála.

Following the successful changeover to Year 2000, the Technology Division concentrated on the continuing upgrade of computer and operational systems. Among the issues that challenged the Division during the year were the impending changeover to the Euro which will occur in January 2002, the ongoing conversion to digital radio and television production, aspirations for improved quality and increased productivity, together with the need to keep RTÉ's technical infrastructure operating at peak efficiency.

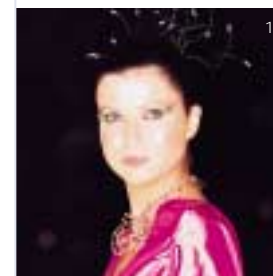
The pilot regional opt-out programme launched in the autumn has provided invaluable technical and operational experience going into the digital multi-channel environment.

Property and Infrastructure: The new Television Programmes Building was brought on stream and over 400 staff were accommodated in a period of five months. The programme for roll out of new high specification PCs began in that building and will continue at the rate of approximately 800 per year.

Environment: The year was one of great challenge. Increasingly stringent regulations resulted in much activity in such areas as waste disposal and hygiene. These will remain the focus of considerable resources in the coming year.

NETCO: The year also saw continued planning for the introduction of Digital Terrestrial Television (DTT). The project for the sale of RTÉ's transmission network business was progressed and the operation is now fully prepared for the expected sale in mid 2001. RTÉ will retain a share of 28% in the new company. The new company will be the primary provider of analogue and digital radio and television services to RTÉ and licensed commercial broadcasters.

The Public Affairs Division continued its programme of public meetings and held its first Campus Roadshow in UCC with a subsequent meeting in UCD. During the year, meetings were held in Wexford, Kilkenny, Roscommon, Mayo, Killarney, Cork and Dublin. These meetings provide the public with an opportunity to question the Director-General and senior executives from Television, Radio and News about RTÉ's broadcasting policy and programming issues. Television and radio personalities and presenters also attend the meetings.

RTÉ announced its sponsorship of Fota Wildlife Park in October 2000. As part of the sponsorship arrangement, RTÉ will support conservation projects managed by the Wildlife Park. Seventy-five pupils from Scoil Íosa Naofa attended the Fota party to announce RTÉ's support and the occasion was also marked by a special edition of *Mooney Goes Wild On One* from Fota Wildlife Park.

The sixth RTÉ Taispeántas Shannon Design Show was held in Athlone in November. The awards are for young designers from all over the island of Ireland and there is no age limit. The only consideration is that the designers are not established in the fashion business prior to entry. The show has grown from strength to strength and is now the biggest fashion show in Ireland.

During the year the Public Affairs Division arranged familiarisation tours of RTÉ for TDs, Senators and local councillors.

The Public Affairs Division also increased its publicity and information service to the media and to the public. Proactively, it organises press briefings and photo opportunities, and supplies a weekly flow of information and photographs to media nationwide, covering RTÉ's output of radio and television programmes, while also responding to numerous queries and requests on a daily basis.
