



Internet Safety

10 Rules to keep you safe and happy on the internet:

- 01** Never give out any personal information such as your full name, address, phone number, school name or parent's work.
- 02** Only use a computer when an adult is nearby.
- 03** Tell an adult if you come across anything that makes you upset, scared or uncomfortable.
- 04** Never send a picture to anyone you don't know or haven't met before. If you are sending pictures to a good friend or relative, make sure your parents say it's ok to send it.
- 05** Never arrange to meet up with someone you meet on the internet, even if you feel you have become good friends and they seem really nice.
- 06** Use a mixture of letters, numbers and symbols in any passwords you have, to make it hard to guess. Never give your password to anyone except your parents.
- 07** Don't download anything from the internet without asking a parent first. It could be unsafe and damage the computer.
- 08** Do not engage with cyberbullies, tell a parent straight away if someone is being mean to you online, or making you feel uncomfortable.





- 09** Do not be a cyberbully. Don't say mean and hurtful things to other. Think of how you would feel if those words were said to you.
- 10** Do not buy anything online without your parent's permission.
