Get creative and try making different animals like below:

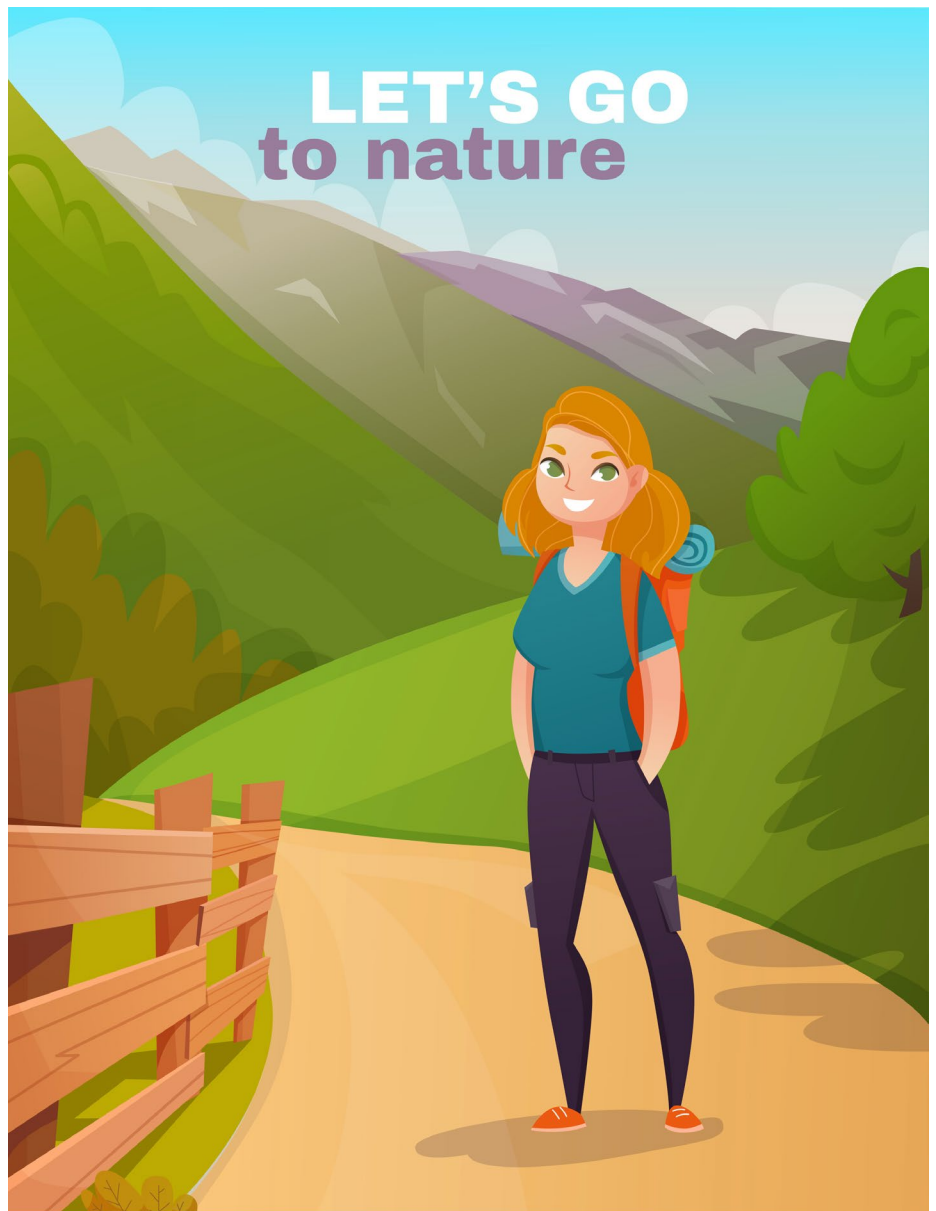




## Spring Walk with an Adult

Spring is a great time to discover all the new flowers and plants that start growing. Next time you go for a walk in the park, see if how many plants and flowers you can tick off the list.

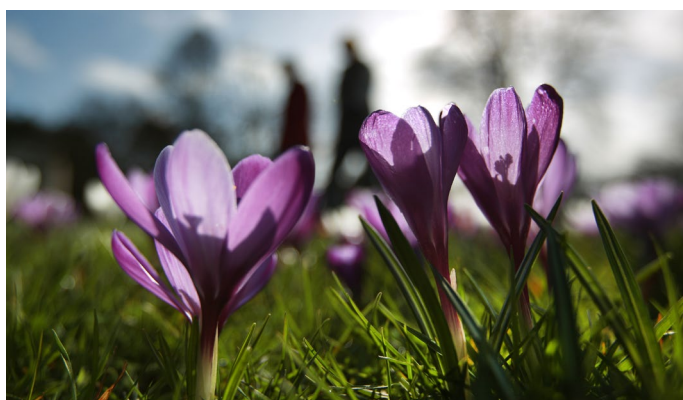

## 3. Crocus



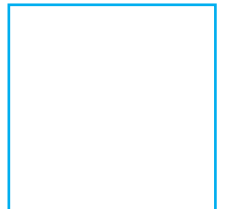

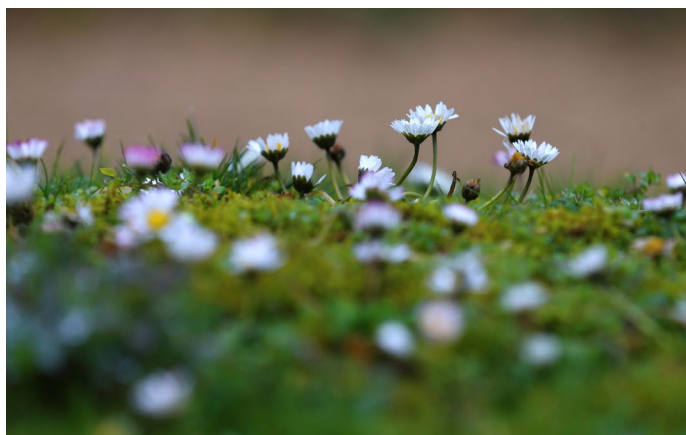
