Adjectives

In today's EXCELLENT class, Múinteoir John told us about all the AMAZING words we can use to make our sentences INTERESTING to read.

An adjective is a describing word. In the sentence above, **EXCELLENT, AMAZING** and **INTERESTING** are all adjectives. Adjectives can make a sentence more exciting and give more detail.








Describe these Dinosaurs!
